ORDER

No. D. 32019/10/2018-HMS, the 13th September 2018. Whereas, it is considered expedient in the public interest and in the interest of the safety and security of the place described in column 2 of the Schedule to this order and its area (hereinafter referred to as the 'said place') that special precautions should be taken to prevent the entry of unauthorized persons;

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by Sub-Section (1) of Section 13A and Sub-Section (1) of Section 13B of the Assam Maintenance of Public Order (Autonomous District) Act, 1953 (Assam Act No. XVI of 1953), the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to declare the said place and area to be protected area respectively, and in exercise of powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 13A and Section 13B of the said Act, the Governor is further pleased to authorize the officer specified in column 3 of the Schedule to this order as persons competent to issue permission under the said Sub-Section in respect of protected place and protected area mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 2 of the Scheduled.

No person shall, without permission of the Governor or of any officer authorized under paragraph 2 or of the District Magistrate or of Sub-Divisional Magistrate having jurisdiction, enter, or to be on or in or pass over the said place and area and no person shall loiter in the vicinity of the said place and area subject to the exemption that this order will not apply to Magistrate, Armed Forces personnel. BRTF personnel and Civil Police on duty.

This order shall come into force with effect from the date of its publication in the Mizoram Gazette.
