NOTIFICATION

No.F.22015/1/2012-HM, the 25th November, 2016. In continuation of the existing guidelines for the enforcement of the Inner Line Regulation in Mizoram issued vide No.F.22016/5/2011-HMP dt.13.8.2014 and in the interest of the public, the Governor of Mizoram, in exercise of the power conferred by Para 2 of the Bengal Eastern Frontier Regulation, 1873 (V of 1873) is pleased to issue modification of the following existing guidelines for regulating the entry and stay of non-indigenous persons within the Inner Line of Mizoram as notified in the Notification No. 2106 A.P. dated 9th March, 1933 published in the Assam Gazette Part-II dated 15th March, 1933. The following modification shall come into force from the date of publication in the Official Gazette:

1. Temporary Stay Permit.

- (a) In partial modification of proviso to Para 3(1) of the extant Guidelines, Temporary Stay permit may be given for the following purpose for a specific period not exceeding a period of one month and which shall not be extended after the expiry of the mentioned period.
- (i) for religious purpose.
 - (ii) for educational purpose/research activities related to Private and Public institutions, sports and entertainment.
 - (iii) matters in connection with the construction works, etc under the Government Departments and PSUs.
 - (iv) Private and Public Bank officials.
- (b) the temporary stay permit shall be issued for the above purposes only after obtaining documentary proof of the purpose of visit and necessary assurance of the applicant by the institutions/departments/banks/offices etc.
- (c) if a period of stay is to exceed the prescribed one month under temporary stay permit, the applicant shall be issued regular ILP of 6 (six) months. Further, the temporary stay permit fee shall be Rs. 200/-

2. SPONSORSHIP

In continuation of Para 18(1)(a) self-sponsorship shall be applicable in the case of Non-Tribal Trade Licence holders after obtaining necessary approval from competent authority (ies) and accordingly, Para 18(a)(i) shall stand deleted.
